Getting to Limerick:

Shannon Airport is the closest airport to Limerick with connections to London Stansted, Gatwick and Heathrow (allowing European connections) and some other UK destinations, and Paris CDG. Dublin is connected to most European destinations and the train from Dublin to Limerick takes ~ 2 ¼ hours.

Directions

From Shannon airport:

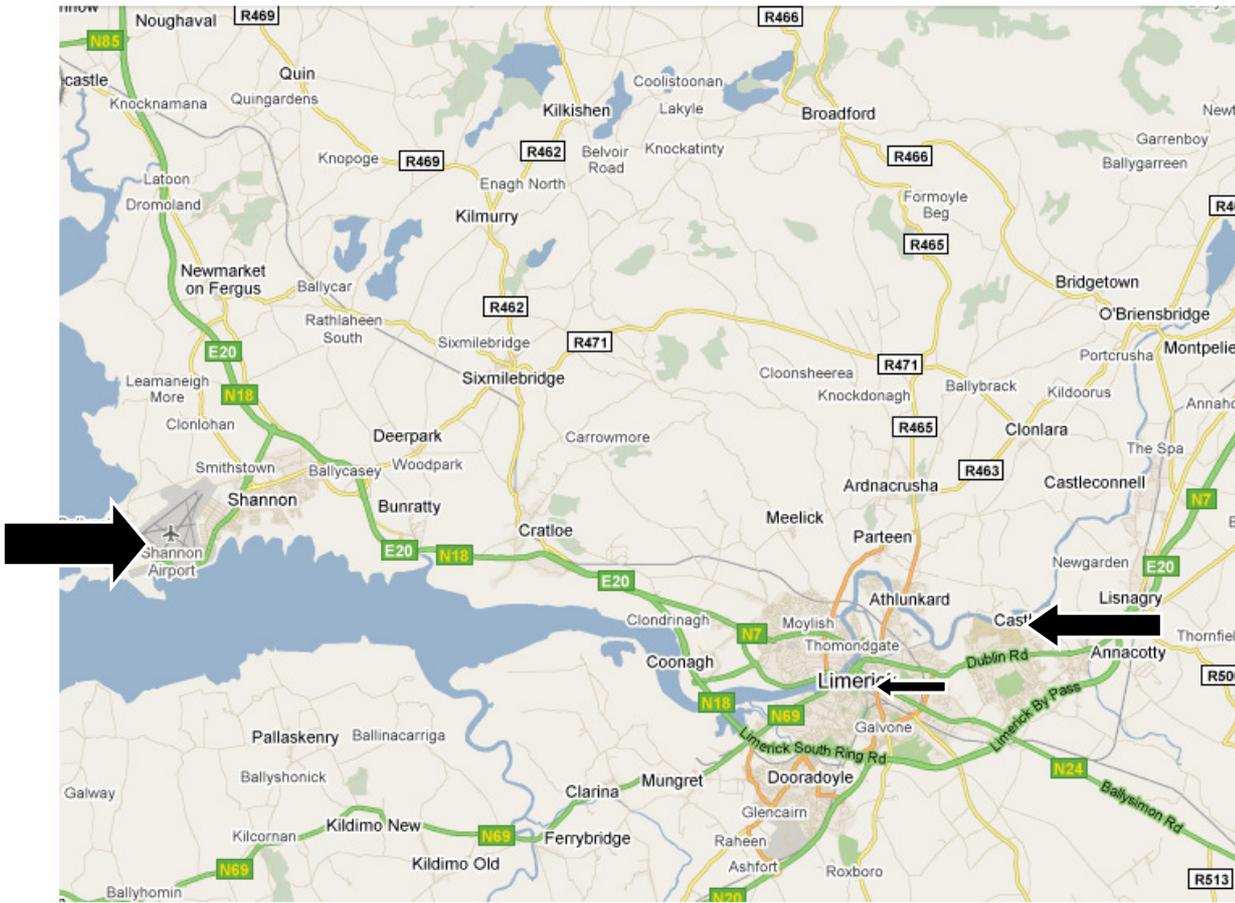
There is an international airport at Shannon, about 20 km from Limerick. There are connections to London Stansted (Ryanair), Heathrow (Aer Lingus) and Gatwick (Ryanair and Aer Lingus), allowing connections to European destinations.

From the airport take a bus or a taxi (cost ~ €40.00) to the hotel.

The bus (number 343), to Limerick train/bus station, goes every hour, and every half hour from 17.00 – 19.00.

From Limerick train & bus station:

You will need to take a taxi from here to the Kilmurry Lodge hotel (or whatever hotel you have booked). This should cost approximately €10.00 – 15.00. There will be taxis just outside the station, as indicated on the map below. (Big arrow = airport, little arrow = train station, medium arrow = hotel)



From Dublin airport:

Take bus 747 to Heuston train station, this will cost €6.00. From the train station take the train to Limerick, you may have to change trains at Limerick Junction. This typically takes 2.5 hours, and goes every hour. It is cheaper to book train tickets online prior to your journey, however you may also purchase tickets at Heuston station before travelling. Alternatively there is a bus from Dublin airport to Limerick. This is slower, and may take 3-4 hours. This service leaves approximately every 2 hours. The timetable is attached, and the bus company is J.J. Kavanagh's. Tickets can be bought on the bus or online: <http://www.jjkavanagh.ie/en/timetables>

Prices should be approximately €20.00 for a single ticket, and €30.00 for a return ticket. The bus goes from the coach park in Dublin airport (Terminal 1). If you get this bus you can get off the bus at the University of Limerick, which is in walking distance to your hotel, but if you ask the driver nicely beforehand he should let you off at your hotel, as it is on the route.
